R-CRISIS OBTAINED OUTSTANDING RESULTS IN THE MOST RECENT PEER CENTER SEISMIC HAZARD ANALYSIS CODE VERIFICATION

The Pacific Earthquake Engineering Research Center (PEER Center) has recently published the results of their latest seismic hazard analysis code verification process. R-CRISIS has proven to have an outstanding performance in the different tests, which had several degrees of complexity and accounted for variations in seismicity and geometry models, for how the ruptures are modelled and for the consideration of uncertainties in the code.
